RESOLUTION NO. 2012-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PASADENA, FLORIDA, OPPOSING FLORIDA HOUSE BILL 4025 AND FLORIDA SENATE BILL 760 TO REPEAL CHAPTER 205 OF THE FLORIDA STATUTES, WHICH WOULD ELIMINATE THE LOCAL BUSINESS TAX ACT RESULTING IN A LOSS OF REVENUE TO THE CITY OF SOUTH PASADENA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, businesses play a critical role in the development and growth of our state by providing jobs, quality goods and services, industry, and entertainment thus helping to create thriving communities in which our citizens can live, work, and participate in recreational activities; and

WHEREAS, many local governments in Florida require businesses operating within their jurisdictions to obtain a Local Business Tax Receipt and revenues collected in this form assist in sustaining the services provided for the citizenry in the funding of many public services to businesses; and

WHEREAS, local governments continue to explore areas to operate efficiently without reducing services and the utilization of the Local Business Tax revenue is one of several tools to help accomplish this goal and has provided General Fund revenues in the amount of \$90,000 in Fiscal Year 2010-2011; and

WHEREAS, a Business Tax Receipt is a local option and local governments are best able to determine whether a Business Tax Receipt should be required and the City of South Pasadena supports the Home Rule authority allowing Florida's local governments to institute and maintain programs that promote the health, safety, and welfare of its' citizenry.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of South Pasadena that:

SECTION 1. The above Whereas clauses are true and correct and are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 2. The City of South Pasadena, Florida, opposes Florida House Bill 4025 and Florida Senate Bill 760 to repeal chapter 205 of Florida Statutes, which would eliminate the local business tax act resulting in a loss of revenue.

SECTION 3. The City of South Pasadena, Florida, requests its' Legislative delegation to oppose the repeal of Chapter 205 of the Florida Statutes eliminating Home Rule authority to impose Local Business Taxes.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

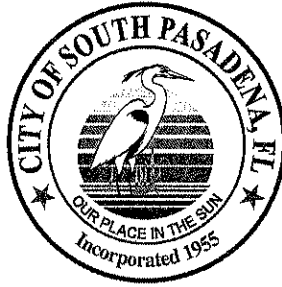


We are pleased to tell you the remaining proceeds will be donated to the *Children's Burn Foundation of Florida*. As always, your participation will be an integral part of the success of this event.
